Day 1 • Monday, May 13 • Home / Shenandoah Valley

We depart today for a tour of the historic Pennsylvania Dutch-Amish Country. Through the rolling countryside, we travel back in time when life was simpler and at a slower pace. We see horse and buggies and one-room schoolhouses. Our first day's travel will carry us into Virginia, where we will spend our first overnight. 


Day 2 • Tuesday, May 14 • Shenandoah Valley / Eden Resort

Today following an **included breakfast** we continue on to Lancaster, Pennsylvania, which is the heart of the Pennsylvania Dutch Country. We will check into our hotel, the lovely Eden Resort, our home for the next three nights. Tonight it's an **included dinner**.

Day 3 • Wednesday, May 15 • Hershey Touring / "Camelot"

After an **included breakfast**, it's on to Chocolate Tour U.S.A., Hershey, PA with our local guide. Discover the hometown of Milton S. Hershey, with street lights shaped like Hershey's Kisses chocolates and the sweet aroma of America's favorite flavor in the air. This morning we'll visit Chocolate World with its gorgeous grounds. We'll take a tour on automated cars into a simulated world of chocolate productions, from a cacao bean plantation in the tropics to a chocolate-making factory in Hershey. We may want to shop for special chocolate while here! This evening we'll enjoy an **included dinner** and **"Camelot"** at the Dutch Apple Dinner Theatre. The legendary love triangle of King Arthur, Guenevere and Sir Lancelot comes alive in this classic musical, including unforgettable hits, "If Ever I Would Leave You", "I Loved You Once In Silence" and "Camelot".



Day 4 • Thursday, May 16 • Amish Home / “Jesus” at Sight and Sound Theatre

Following our **included breakfast**, today we will continue our touring with our local guide of the Amish Farmlands as we venture out onto the “Roads Less Traveled” through the heart of Amish Farmlands. As we enjoy the picturesque scenery, pristine farms, one-room schoolhouses, windwheels, Amish “phone booths” and farmers working their mule-drawn plows and the Amish Quilt & Craft Shop. This afternoon we’ll watch one of the most captivating stories in the Bible come to life on the giant screen at Sight & Sound Theatre. “**Jesus**”, a musical stage adventure that takes us on a miraculous journey alongside the most famous person to ever walk the earth and the everyday people whose lives he changed forever. This evening we’ll have a true **Pennsylvania Dutch included dinner** in an Amish Home, an experience a visitor never forgets. A wonderfully good Dutch consists of wonderful country meats, delicious, buttered noodles, vegetables, baked bread, and mouth-watering desserts. We will be able to eat to our heart’s content!



Day 5 • Friday, May 17 • Gettysburg / Flight 93 National Memorial Site / Virginia

Today after our **included breakfast** it’s a walk through American history as we stop at Gettysburg Military Park. The park comprises the Gettysburg battlefield where one of the most important and hotly contested battle of the Civil War was waged. On November 19, 1863, President Lincoln dedicated Gettysburg National Cemetery on the battlefield, delivering the most famous speech, the Gettysburg Address. Following our tour of this historic site, we have an **included lunch** at the Dobbins House Tavern before we overnight in the Gettysburg area.

Day 6 • Saturday, May 18 • Shanksville, PA

After another **included breakfast**, it is on to Shanksville, PA and the Flight 93 National Memorial Site, encompassing 2,200 acres filled with 40 memorial grove trees and a field of honor where guests are able to walk along the crash site. And along with the Tower of Voices, a visitor’s center opened three years ago, and a memorial plaza was dedicated on the 10th anniversary in 2011. In recent years, the memorial opened a museum with mementos recovered from the crash site. Following our tour of this historic site, we have an **included lunch** before it’s southbound with an overnight in Virginia.



Day 7 • Sunday, May 19 • Home Today


